## Education plan for International Master's Programme in Political Science (SU)

### Semester 1

- Analytical Perspectives and the Study of Power in the Social Sciences, 15 credits
- Two optional theme courses in political science, each course 7.5 credits

### Semester 2

- Analysis of Democracy, 7.5 credits
- 1 optional theme course in political science, 7.5 credits
- Methods in Political Science, 15 credits (select: "Qualitative methods" or "Quantitative methods")

### Semester 3

Independent Research Project in Political Science, 30 credits

### Semester 4

Vocational internship, 15, 22.5 or 30 credits and/or optional theme and/or method courses at an advanced level chosen in consultation with the Director of Studies, and/or exchange studies at an advanced level, maximum 30 credits
