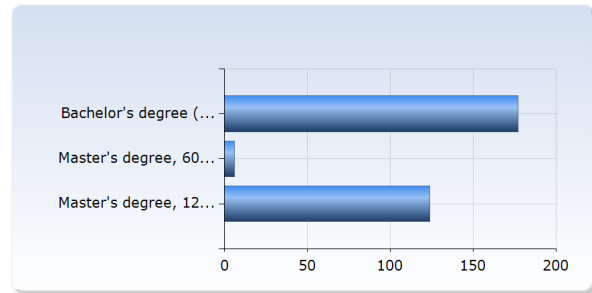

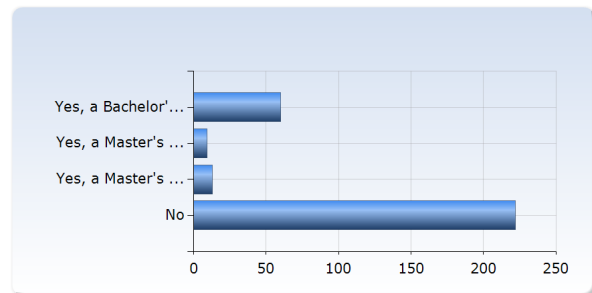

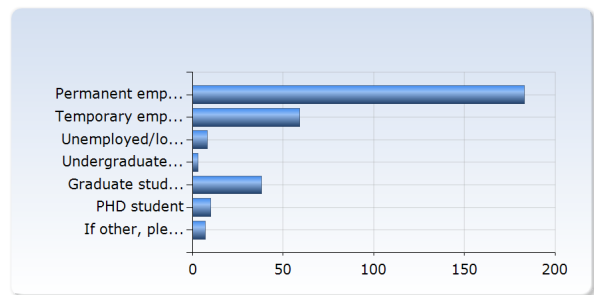

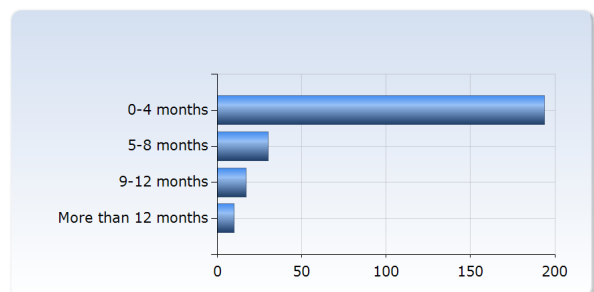

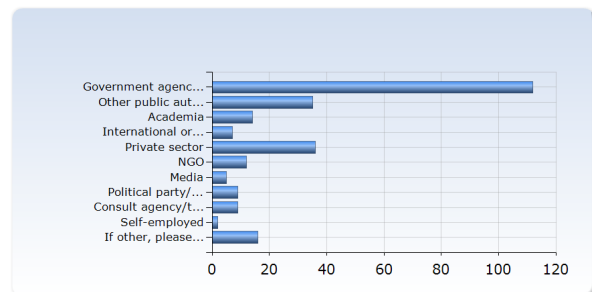

Do an internship

Gör praktik på en arbetsplats där du får pröva dina färdigheter och din inriktning. Om du vill arbeta med utredningar bör du göra praktik på en arbetsplats där du får träna på detta!

I would advise you to do one or two internships in order to find out what you like and in order to demonstrate your interest on your CV.

Internship

Nätverka under studieperioden. Gå med i någon organisation, ämnesråd, jobba ideellt etc.

Lägg mycket tid och fokus på metodkurserna som ges, dessa kunskaper är oerhört värdefulla ute i arbetslivet.

Work part time during your studies in the field in which you would to work in after your studies. It is very difficult to get a job without any previous working experience in that field.

Do an internship. That's my best advise.

Intern, intern, intern. Work, work, work.

Numerous of the students with the highest grades in my class are still unemployed, or employed within sectors unrelated to political science, whilst the ones who spent time interning, working and getting contacts outside the academic world are the ones with the highest salaries and most rewarding jobs.

Don't slack. Get your degree - but remember: contacts and experience is far more important than grades! (Unless you want an office at Frescati).

Do an internship - it's the best way into the working life for students in this sector, which is otherwise very broad and it is difficult for students to know by graduation where to look for work. The internship is a very important stepping stone in order to limit your choices when it comes to the first employment opportunity after graduation.

Care about doing things well. Try different things to get to know what your interests really are. Study according to your interests. Take an internship.

Make sure to do an internship if you have the opportunity!

Do the internship!

You'll learn what you studied theoretically on a practical level

Join networks of your interest while you are studying, prioritise field work over theoretical classes and write your final thesis in close connection with an organization in order to get new connections and work experience.

Emphasize your interests (academical and societal) when applying for a job.

It is good idea to search for lower level entry jobs and then to work your way up the ladder. Meaning sometimes doing work which is below your level of competence. Also not having a fixed idea of what kind of work that best define your competence, political science is a very broad subject. Use that.

To make it in the labour market, whether in Sweden or abroad, it is important to develop a large network and do internships in relevant organisations.

Really Think about where you want to intern, because that will be a really good in to further employment and Contacts.

Do the internship. Period.

Don't get too caught up in your grades. They really don't matter if you want to get a job outside academia after you graduate. It's more important to have experience from abroad, having done a thesis that you're really interested in, and having done an internship.

Apply for internships and study abroad

Do internships at good places and do some networking

Personal engagement in NGO:s eg is an important complement to studies and a good opportunity to get prepared for working life

It's a broad education, just think outside the box.

Tänk utanför offentlig sektor. Våga skriva uppsats om något som verkligen intresserar. Uppsatsarbete ger möjlighet till att bli "expert" inom ett ämne vilket är jättebra. Det är också bra att välja en praktikplats där en hög examen inte är norm. På detta sätt klättrar man högt inom organisationen på kort tid och man har möjlighet att bygga kontakter med makthavare och bra personer som i en offentlig sektor hade varit svårare.

Focus more on analysis, critical thinking, how you work in a group and presentation, hence skills you learn, rather than the specific field when you apply for a job.

My best advice is to apply for an internship, do volunteering work if possible and proactively updating knowledge even outside the field of Political Science.

Take additional courses

Det behövs en tydligare koppling till arbetsgivarna. Fokus ligger mer på det akademiska, vilket självklart är viktigt. Dock kan inte alla fortsätta inom akademien. Mandatory internships or optional more labour market-oriented courses for those studying a programme and who are not planning to become researchers.

Do internships and work on the side is the most important. Start doing research about potential employers (also within private sector).

Be prepared for a rough transition into the seemingly boring lobotomy of working a regular job. Your knowledge of academic writing is hindering, and elected officials can not understand things with references or footnotes.

Don't study political science and expect a relevant career in the near future unless you have contacts

There should absolutely be a closer connection between the academia and future working places, for instance in the public administration, Government offices, different organizations etc. Take a look at Economic or Juridical institutions for some inspiration in this sense.

To me, most of humanity appear to be stuck in a complex system of power relations where we are alienated from our everyday experience of life and what is truly important to us. Leaving university and entering the labour market, you either become oppressed or an oppressor. As I see it, working for an international organization or at the top of a government agency renders a person with a lot of status, power, a big ego and a flashy life style. However, I doubt that such a job at the end of the day makes a person happy nor contributes to making the world a better place.

Thus, I believe that the most important thing to teach the political science students is to be more revolutionary and that we have to change our society and what we value.

Try different fields and find your passion first, finding work in your field is secondary. I did an internship as part of my own initiative to find a job within my field, and it paid off. I am now working in a field that I feel passionate about, that where I can apply my knowledge in political science, specifically in gender and development.

More teacher led training overall (we had 4 hours per week which is just a disaster!) More practical exercises. More internships.

I think that taking courses in methodology and statistics really pays off. Other than that, I believe that students of political science often acquire a broad, generalist foundation, which is also beneficial when applying for jobs.

Get an internship!

Study hard, focus on developing analyzing skills and also on methods. Apply for jobs you think you're underqualified for. You'll be surprised.

Keep looking while keeping your heads down

Work. A part-time job at McDonald's, a café or a cleaning firm will prepare you better for working life than any education will.

Pay particularly close attention during the courses in methods

Jag rekommenderar studenter att göra en termins praktik eftersom utbildningen är ganska teoretisk. För mig fungerade det som ett bra komplement och gav en möjlighet att "testa på" en verksamhet under en termin. Mina tips för att få ut så mycket som möjligt av praktiken är att visa sin vilja att lära sig, att våga testa svårare uppgifter, och framförallt att vara öppen för att lära sig av andra på praktikplatsen. Jag rekommenderar också studenter att fundera ett extra varv kring vad de vill få ut av praktiken inför valet av praktikplats, och att försöka lägga en del tid på själva ansökan.

Do an internship, independently if necessary. The experience and contacts that you will make from that is the primary resources you can utilize to eventually get employment with qualified working tasks. However, it all depends on the kind of working life you want to pursue, think about this in order to plan long-term. Do you want to work in government or private sector? Specialization role or management? Independently or part of a department? Try to think and honestly answer these questions as they apply to you and this will significantly help you prepare for working life.

Be patient and push yourself even if it's hard!

Erfarenhet är jätte viktigt. Jobba extra!

Issue demands and ask uncomfortable questions towards your institution at SU. Get the education you are entitled to!

Svårt att få drömjobbet som första jobb efter studierna. Ta "vilket jobb som helst" kopplat till din utbildning. Sen är det mycket lätt (med utbildning och arbetslivserfarenhet) att klättra, byta jobb.

Internships, learn English well and network within academia as well as beyond

Den enskilt största anledningen till att jag snabbt fick ett roligt och stimulerande jobb var den praktik jag genomförde under sista terminen på masterprogrammet. Otroligt värdefullt och lärorikt. Gav en fot in på arbetsmarknaden och bra erfarenhet. Bara att ha en examen öppnar många dörrar, sen spelar det inte alltid en så stor roll vad man pluggat! Man har visat att man kan ta till sig information på en högre nivå!

If you have big goal in mind, make sure you have a back-up plan. Also, I would highly recommend you to take complementary courses in statistics and business administration (I didn't, but I think it would very much help me in my working life).

To get a headstart in recruitment, it is best to specialise on a topical issue, e.g. currently immigration. In general, it seems that national or lower level politics and various social issues are better specialisations than international politics.

Do internships, traineeships, etc.

Develop a large network with people in the profession (e.g. through mentorships etc.)

Get involved in politics or other organizations

Follow your interest

Internships by the university, hard to find it for yourself.

Have fun and keep an open mind about potential career opportunities.

Know someone who knows someone:)

- Do an internship, there are few fields where contacts and previous experience are as important as within Political Science.

- Be clear about what you want with your studies from the beginning, don't wait until you graduate!

- Follow a programme instead of individual courses to make sure you have all the necessary competences.

- Specialize as much as possible in one particular field in order to make your CV stand out.

- Take courses in English instead of Swedish if available (for Swedish students), and make sure you go for exchange in another country to learn a third language (French, German, Spanish, Chinese, Japanese, Arabic are highly encouraged).

It's a lot more than theories. And how much I didn't wanted to admit it, personal contacts matters. Social networks are important.

Tänk noga och strategiskt vid val av praktikplats. Var aktiv utanför studierna, skapa goda kontakter och nätverk.

Internships

Emphasis / discussions on how the subjects and knowledges from each course could be used in workinglife and academia (differences and similarities in the different settings)

Visiting lectures from outside the academia (from different sectors - private, public, NGO:s and so on)

Accnowledging the strong academic norm and take responsibility for the different interest - (in the student population and within the academia). A majority of the students will leave the academy for working life, this should be acknowledged and respected, instead of educating students as if all of them are interested in or actually could become researchers. When I studied the sub text from teachers was like "you should study hard and rise within the academia". I lacked a honest discussion about the fact that there is not place in the academy for all students who want to become researchers. I also lacked the perspective that working outside of the academia is not a bad alternative, inferior to a academic career.

Not anything other than what is already suggested: internships, exchange studies, networking... And to be patient, one thing usually leads to another.

Make sure to do one-two internships in the right field. Make as many contacts as you can in your field. If circumstances permit do a Masters degree too.

Yes I do. Skip taking a Master's Degree and instead learn a third major language really well. It's not that the education in itself is bad (in my opinion it is indeed valuable from a personal point of view) but the fact is that it just does not matter. I was most disappointed as I started looking for jobs.

I studied hard and got good grades. I did my internship at the Ministry for Foreign Affairs and received two strong letters of recommendation. And then nothing happened for six months. I applied for 150 jobs and got 5 interviews before I landed a temporary job. It is a joke! I honestly feel cheated by SU and wish that someone could have given me the advice above a few years back. Yes, I do.

I firmly believe that had I spent two years studying Chinese, Russian or Arabic I would never have been this unattractive at the job market. I know that I am not alone in this dilemma, of course, and I feel bad for everyone that have to go through all this.

Like I said, I don't think the Master's Programme is bad in any aspect. But employers do not care about it. No one I've met has asked me what my Master's Degree have given me or explained how it makes me more suitable than any other applicant with a lesser degree. So why waste two valuable years doing something that leads to nothing? A Bachelor's Degree plus advanced knowledge in a major third language would most certainly have led me to a far more attractive position today.

Get an internship, because getting job experience and people who can vouch for you is very valuable.

It would appear based on my initial experience that having a Master Degree in Pol Sci would have given me better chance of landing a position in the field, since several posting and vacancy cite the holding of a Master degree as a requirement...Also I would highly recommend doing a semester abroad to gain international experience and perspectives, coupled with an internship.

Om man har en dröm om att få jobba på en särskild arbetsplats/befattning. Sök jobb först som man är överkvalificerad för, för att komma in internt (t.ex. kundtjänst som jag gjorde)

Applicera teorier och tankegångar på nutida och verkliga situationer. Fokusera på konkreta kursval som du kan använda dig av på framtida arbetsplatser och som du har nytta av vid en intervjusituation.

Ha engagemang på fritiden.

Get active in a student organisation or an NGO that works in the field of your interest. This will allow you to get practical experience of working with questions that interest you and create contacts with people in your field.

Find a student job that will give you basic administrative work experience since employers will value that once you're done with your studies. Simply having studied for 3 or 5 years isn't valued as an experience by most employers.

Take the opportunity of doing an internship. It's probably one of the most important things a student can do during their studies.

Get involved in associations, assume responsibility for organizing activities, lectures, study trips!

Join a trade union active in your future field of work to get information.

Allstudents doesn't strive for employment in the public sector, something I felt was assumed during my time. I do think that you could invite the private sector more for inspirational seminars. I believe that the social science background is a great foundation for a private career!

Make sure you do an internship somewhere and keep contact with your fellow colleagues.

Work part time in as relevant fields as possible for your studies/interests. Get engaged in student associations for practical work experience and a great network of people with same interests. Go abroad and do an internship in order to get a clue of what kind of work may interest you in the future.

Try to study a broader degree such as Political science with Economy in order to have more work opportunities.

Work hard but don't forget to have fun during your studies. Take the opportunity to engage yourself in relevant community and meet people from different background. Sometimes you need to ask yourself "what is good enough"

Internships are essential since the studies are so theoretical.

Internships and engagement with industry. I feel I would have benefited from focussing on both aspects earlier in my degree - right from the start. In my case my internship started my career and proved to be a stronger bedrock for future professional opportunities than any of the courses I took at SU. I feel the Department could help students by instilling the need for work experience in students from as early as possible.

1. For the university: a) All courses should have a section on practical application of theory. This is by far the biggest challenge for a student of political science, and instructors MUST assist in this analysis/application. b) I feel that some training (within the master's program) in writing and presentation techniques as well as project management could have been good complements to my education. 2. For students: We live in a rapidly changing world, where we don't know where we will be living or working in the future. Therefore, prepare yourself with transferable skills (överförbara färdigheter), such as writing in different genres, presentation technique, project management, language, etc. that are useful in many different jobs.

Take an internship, it's the only way to get into the fields and to get to know people.

Find a topic that motivates you and then search for any employment that has some connection to it. Don't be too picky at first but also don't settle for something where you don't see yourself learning/advancing. Invest time in learning languages and if you have the means go abroad. Tell people what motivates you and where you are heading. Use your connections, if you don't have any make some (both Twitter and LinkedIn have worked me to establish connections).

Build experience doing something you enjoy!

Focus on internship
