## Delkurs 1: Perspektiv på politik, 7.5 hp

### BESKRIVNING

Delkursen behandlar teorins roll i samhällsvetenskapliga studier samt ger kännedom om inflytelserika teoretiska traditioner. Vidare ger kursen kännedom om hur teorier används och kommer till uttryck i empiriska studier. Syftet med kursen är att ge insikter i hur teori påverkar ämnesval, formulering av forskningsfrågor, studiedesign samt vilket slags resultat som kan förväntas. Delkursen syftar till att öka kännedomen/fördjupa kunskapen/ om relationen mellan teoretisk ansats och analys av empiriskt material samt uppmuntrar till kritisk reflektion kring en teoriers implikationer för studiens upplägg.

### MÅL

- Skriftligt och muntligt kunna redogöra för samhällsteoretiska perspektiv på ett innehållsligt och språkligt vederhäftigt sätt
- Redogöra för de olika teorier som presenteras på kursen och deras grundläggande kännetecken.
- Redogöra för betydelsen av teori för en vetenskaplig studies syfte, frågeställning, design samt vilken slags resultat som kan förväntas.
- Göra egna analyser genom att ta hjälp av begrepp eller andra centrala element ur de olika teorier som presenteras på kursen.
- Visa förmåga att förstå och granska de teorier som presenteras på kursen, samt ge prov på medveten reflektion kring perspektivval och dessas implikationer för en vetenskaplig studie.

### **Delkurs 3: Förvaltningspolitiska dilemman, 7,5 hp**

#### **BESKRIVNING**

Förvaltningens roll i den representativa demokratin står i centrum i denna kurs. Relationen mellan politik och förvaltning, och mellan politiker och tjänstemän, studeras teoretiskt och empiriskt på såväl statlig som kommunal nivå. Tre frågor ägnas särskild uppmärksamhet. Den första handlar om förvaltningens makt och frågan om, och i så fall hur, politiskt valda företrädare kan styra förvaltningen. Den andra handlar om professioner i offentlig förvaltning, vad som kännetecknar professioner och vilka krav som ställs på professioner i det offentliga. Den tredje handlar om

tjänstemannarollen och de olika förvaltningspolitiska värden som tjänstemännen har att värna i sitt dagliga värv.

Delkursen består av fyra föreläsningar och fyra seminarier med obligatorisk närvaro. Till varje seminarium ska studenten lämna en läsrapport. Frånvaro kompletteras med skriftlig inlämningsuppgift. Komplettering accepteras vid högst ett tillfälle.

- redogöra för vad styrningsbegreppet innebär och hur offentlig styrning kan förstås;
- redogöra för vad som kännetecknar professioner i offentlig förvaltning,
- redogöra för vilka värden som kringgärdar offentliganställda och vad dessa värden har för betydelse i termer av rolluppfattningar och lojaliteter hos tjänstemän som arbetar i förvaltningen.

Färdigheter och förmågor

- tillämpa olika perspektiv på makt och styrning i analysen av relationen mellan politiker och tjänstemän.

Värderingsförmåga och förhållningssätt

- reflektera och argumentera kritiskt kring relationen mellan politiker och tjänstemän;
- reflektera och argumentera kritiskt kring tjänstemannarollen i moderna demokratier.
